County Council Meetings from 18 May will return to socially distanced face-to-face meetings. The County Council is holding its AGM at Duxford to allow for sufficient space to maintain the necessary social distancing.
East West Rail – the County Council will be discussing proposed routes for the EW Rail at the end of the month.
Fostering – the County Council is supporting a campaign to raise awareness of the impact Fostering can have on children's lives and to recruit more foster carers in the County.

A: Requests for speed watch volunteers has not garnered enough support to get a group of people together.

The Clerk will contact Cambridge Constabulary to find out more about the speed watch scheme and will speak with the Clerk at Hilton PC to enquire about their speed watch setup.

The Clerk will enquire with Highways Dept to see if it is possible to borrow some temporary static speed signs which are able to capture data and also to request advice about speed calming options.
